

Ribbed Hat and Scarf for Ellowyne

Also works for American Models



Materials: Size 1 and Size 2 needles
Fingering weight or sock yarn

Gauge for hat: With size 2 needles, 16sts and 18 rows in a 2X2 swatch

With size 1 needles, cast on 56 sts

Work in k2, p2 rib for 4 rows (knit 2 sts, purl 2 sts across the row for 4 rows)

Switch to size 2 needles and work in stockinette st for 2"

Begin Decreases: *decreases are done on the right side row*

Purl every other row

K2, k2tog across (41sts)

K1, k2tog across k2 (28sts)

K2tog across (14sts)

K2tog across (7sts)

K2tog across (4sts)

Cut yarn, leaving enough for seaming. Thread yarn tail through remaining sts, and pull tight. Use remaining tail to sew back seam. Weave in ends.

Key: Stockinette Stitch: Knit 1 row, purl 1 row

Ribbed Scarf:

Materials: Size 2 needles, Fingering or sock weight yarn

Gauge is not important

Cast on 11 sts

Work k3, p2, k2 across the row, turn

Repeat k3, p2, k2 until desired length

Weave in ends

Attach fringe to ends of scarf if desired
